a horrible and heartbreaking way on Sept. 11.

"We got our legs chopped out from under us on Sept. 11," Clear Channel President/COO Mark Mays told investors as the company released its third-quarter results in early November. The American economy's reversal of fortune came just as Clear Channel and many of its competitors were beginning to see August and September advertising paces pick up steam.

In fact, things were looking up over the summer, and a recovery seemed to already be in the works. Clear Channel beat analysts' Q2 estimates by a penny a share despite the ad slowdown, while Radio One revenue gained 91%, and broadcast cash flow jumped 106%.

By mid-August many were asking, "Is the worst over?" A number of industry leaders thought they saw light at the end of the tunnel. Even Emmis' optimistic CEO, Jeff Snulyan, began looking at taxable spinoffs of the company's TV division as a way to get more value out of the company for shareholders.

But within a few weeks, everything had changed. Terrorists struck New York; Washington, DC; and a field in western Pennsylvania, and broadcasters immediately switched to wall-to-wall news coverage, dumping at least two weeks of revenues. Some estimate that Sept. 11 cost radio \$1 billion.

Still, stations coast to coast raised money for the families of victims. Before September was over, stations owned by such groups as Clear Channel, Citadel, Cox, Emmis, Saga, ABC, Entercom, Radio One, Journal, Cumulus and Jefferson-Pilot had raised more than \$35 million.

And, despite the loss of revenue, Sept. 11 seems to have brought listeners back to radio — and they are listening longer and more often.

Big Deals In 2001

Citadel founder, Chairman and CEO Larry Wilson never seemed to enjoy the public part of running a publicly owned company. So halfway through January he cut a deal with

every major media market in the U.S. I strongly encourage every newspaper and radio station to the run the ads and join us in this fight."

Some broadcasters began airing the PSAs on Dec. 13, a State Department spokesperson said. ABC Radio Networks immediately began helping to distribute the announcements.

One of the four PSAs authorized for radio begins, "Do you know a terrorist?" The chilling script continues, "Not long ago, this would have seemed like a ridiculous question, but not anymore. Stop and think about it. Information about suspicious activities involving aircraft, about stolen explosives or biological materials, about letters or packages. It could all add up to preventing a terrorist attack."

venture-capital company Forstmann Little and JP Morgan Chase to take Citadel private while keeping him in the saddle at the Las Vegas-based operation. By summer the investors had forked over \$2 billion, or \$26 per Citadel share, leaving Wilson to pocket \$49 million.

Just a few weeks after Citadel's big deal, Radio One concluded months of intensive courting with the acquisition of Ross Love's Blue Chip Broadcasting, a group of 15 stations in five markets that fetched \$190 million. It was another in a series of important strategic moves for Radio One, which continued to make deals that had Wall Street analysts humming all year. Love joined Radio One's board of directors.

In March, Viacom closed on its \$12 billion buyout of Infinity Broadcasting, officially putting Viacom Chairman Sumner Redstone and Mel Karmazin, who was named Viacom President/COO, on the same team. Farid Suleman, Infinity's longtime Exec. VP/CFO & Treasurer, was promoted to Infinity President/CEO.

In October, Clear Channel agreed to pay about \$800 million for the Seattle-based Ackerley Group, a conglomerate of radio and TV stations.

In mid-November, Cumulus — vying for the "comeback kid" award of 2001 — said it would buy Aurora's stations, a sizable block of properties in the Northeast, including a New York City bedroom signal, as well as three Dickey Brothers Broadcasting-owned stations in Nashville, all for about \$317 million.

Cumulus, knocked to the ground in March 2000 by the hardest punch a slew of investor class-action suits could deliver, began showing signs of recovery in late March. Its newly appointed CEO, Lew Dickey, said the company was recovering from being "in dire straits from top to bottom." He added, "It took a lot of hard work, a healthy dose of harsh medicine and some good luck to get it going again." Shares of Cumulus, which hit a low of \$3.20 around last New Year's, closed Tuesday at \$16.05.

2001 was also a year for big deals by smaller groups. In July, NBG Radio Network bought Fisher Entertainment for \$5.3 million, all cash, add-

ing 424 of Fisher's affiliates to the 2,300 affiliates NBG already had.

Satellite Radio Rocketing

XM Satellite Radio, trying to catch up with fellow satellite broadcaster Sirius Satellite Radio, got a black eye on Wall Street Jan. 8 when, with 11 seconds to go before launching its "Roll" bird, it had to scrub the mission after an engineer discovered what he thought was an incorrect measurement by the satellite's instrumentation. By mid-March XM was back on track, slipping its other satellite, "Rock," onto the sea-launch pad and successfully sending it into orbit.

And just as XM was happily riding the up escalator, it passed competitor Sirius on the decline, Sirius founder and Chairman/CEO David Margolose told investors on April 2 that the company had failed to get a hard commitment from Detroit automakers to put Sirius receivers into any specific makes or models of cars. Some 4.3 million Sirius shares were sold in one day, sending the share price down 35%, to \$7.56 — a long way from the \$60 per share investors enjoyed just a year before. A short time later the company said it would raise its monthly subscription fee 30%, from \$9.95 to \$12.95.

By May XM had successfully launched "Roll," and in July it began sending "soft launch" test signals into 20 markets. It then announced that it would roll out its service in Dallas and San Diego in September.

By mid-October, with Sirius nearly a year behind its originally announced service rollout date and XM well on its way to completing its own national rollout amid rare reviews, Margolose stepped down as head of Sirius. Within weeks the company recruited Joseph Clayton to replace Margolose. Clayton, who as head of DirecTV a decade ago was credited with making satellite TV household words, caused a rush on Wall Street as Sirius shares jumped from \$2.20 per share to nearly \$10 earlier this week. Sirius is scheduled to roll out its service in Denver, Phoenix and Houston on Feb. 14, 2002, with a complete national service rollout set for completion by the end of Q2 2002.

biggest revenue hits: Business in the top 15 markets is down 7% locally and 24% nationally. Certain of those markets, such as San Francisco, are suffering even bigger decreases.

Fries added that November might be the first month of revenue gains in over a year, particularly in local sales. That said, he still forecasts an 8% overall decline in revenues when the year closes out. As for next year, he expects national business to remain flat and local business to rise 4%.
